PLAN

I'm going to travel to Europe. ♦ *intention*

EVIDENCE

Look! It's going to rain. ♦ *based on what you see*

FORMATION

verb to be + GOING TO + verb

She is going to work · They are going to sleep

♦ AFFIRMATIVE · QUESTION · NEGATIVE

auxiliary main verb

Affirmative	Question	Negative
He is going to <u>drink</u> water.	Is he going to <u>drink</u> water?	He isn't going to <u>drink</u> water.
She is going to <u>listen</u> to music.	Is she going to <u>listen</u> to music?	She isn't going to <u>listen</u> to music.
The kids are going to <u>play</u> .	Are the kids going to <u>play</u> ?	The kids aren't going to <u>play</u> .
The boy is going to <u>smile</u> .	Is the boy going to <u>smile</u> ?	The boy isn't going to <u>smile</u> .
